# Meeting Minutes September 17, 2015

The regular monthly meeting was held at the office of the Department of Land Preservation, 500 Mt. Pisgah Avenue, Oxford, New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Schnetzer at 7:32 p.m. An announcement was read as required by the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6-21.

Chairman Schnetzer led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the meeting held on August 20, 2015 were approved on a motion by Mr. Baduini and seconded by Ms. Willever. Motion carries.

#### **Old Business:**

O'Dowd Properties, Farmland and Open Space Fee Simple Purchase update – Mr. Mylod thanked the CADB from the bottom of his heart and stated that it has been a long and frustrating process for the negotiation of these properties. Mr. Mylod stated that he delivered the executed contracts as is. He stated that he and his family have a long history representing the O'Dowd family as his grandfather and father were their attorneys. Mr. Mylod had brought up possible changes to the contract, the typographical error in a block and lot number, the discrepancy of 42 acres, and an increase for 5% for additional acreage, the ROW and the 11% cap and asked the Board if they would reconsider making modifications to the contract. After much discussion, Mr. Baduini made a motion for the contract to stay the same. Mr. Burke stated that the 5% limit is not fair for the O'Dowd's and that it limits the possibility for the landowners to receive money on the actual surveyed acreage if the missing 42 acres is uncovered during the survey and title work. Chairman Schnetzer asked for a second on the motion three times but none was received so motion dies. Chairman Schnetzer asked for another motion. Mr. Burke made a motion that the contract language be changed to cap any discrepancy at 11%. Mr. Menegus seconded the motion.

Mr. Baduini made a motion as the ROW language remains unchanged in the contract. Mr. Burke seconded the motion. Roll Call: Mr. Schnetzer – yes; Mr. Bodine – yes; Mr. Baduini – yes; Mr. Burke – yes; Ms. Willever – yes; Mr. Menegus – yes. Motion carries.

Mr. Tierney stated that the block and lot error was already corrected in the contract. Mr. O'Dowd thanked the Board on behalf of his family and the same from Mr. Brian O'Dowd.

**SADC Special Occasion Events at Wineries on Preserved Farmland update** – Mr. Tierney stated that the SADC is sending out letters to all wineries in the State to register for a Special Event, but it doesn't apply for Warren County preserved farms with wineries because they don't hold events outside of their exception areas.

**County Farms Funding Discussion** – Mr. Tierney stated that there was \$19,251,000 in the County Farmland Preservation fund and \$2,165,000 in the SADC Competitive Round and that the County's projects total \$2,000,000 for funding by year end. Mr. Tierney talked about the SADC reallocating \$3,000,000 non-profit funds and reallocating other County's and Municipality funds that were not currently active and redistributing the funds to active County and Municipalities. The Corporate Business Income Tax has still not been resolved on the allocation and might not be resolved until 2016. Mr. Tierney stated that their might be a possibility using MUNI PIG funding balances and soliciting other non-profit agencies like William Penn Foundation for a funding source. Mr. Tierney stated that the Highlands Council will be receiving money from PSE&G and will start their own grant program with 50% matching grant for open space and farmland preservation. The funding was received for PSE&G running a pipe line through Hardwick Township.

Hope Township Livestock Ordinance Review/Discussion – The Board stated that some of the language in the ordinace falls outside of Right to Farm.

Administrator's Report: Mr. Tierney briefly went over the status of the applications on the report.

Certification of Commercial Farm – Chelsea Forge Vintners/Alba Vineyard, BL 113 L 6 & BL 110 L 13.02 & 13.04, Pohatcong Township – This application meets the eligibility criteria for Certification of a Commercial Farm which is: (1) Five or more acres, applicant supplied tax map, and; (2) \$2,500 annual income from agricultural and/or horticultural products which was provided by 2014 Schedule F; (3) Satisfies the eligibility criteria for differential property taxation pursuant to the Farmland Assessment Act of 1964, applicant provided Farmland Assessment Form (FA-1 Form), and; (4) Is located in an area in which, as of December 31, 1997 or thereafter, agriculture has been a permitted use under the municipal zoning ordinance and is consistent with the municipal master plan. Tom Sharko is the landowner for this block and lot.
