WHEREAS, the permanent preservation of lands devoted to open space is in the public interest and benefits the citizens of Warren County and that the purchase of open space to accomplish the preservation of said land is a worthwhile and prudent expenditure of public funds; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Open Space, Farmland, and Historic Trust Fund makes monies available for the purchase of open space and farmland in order to permanently preserve said properties; and
