### LEGAL NOTICE

The meeting of the Warren County Board of Elections was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Board Chair Robert Stead.

### ROLE CALL

Present: Board Chair Robert Stead, Board Secretary Harry Brown, Commissioner Gloria Decker, Commissioner Charles Boddy, and Board Administrator Bill Duffy.

### PUBLIC COMMENT

### POLLING PLACES

Mr. Duffy suggested to the Board that the Independence polling location for 3 of the 4 district become the Fire Hall. It has enough room and parking and will resolve the issues that occurred during the General Election. He is also looking for a place in Blairstown that could handle 2 of the 5 districts. This would provide more space at the municipal building for the other 3 districts. There is a church located near the North Warren High School which may be available.

### NEW MACHINES

#### Demonstrations

The Mr Duffy is scheduling demonstrations to civic groups in order to provide the public with an opportunity to see the new voting machines before the Primary Election.

#### New Bags

We are currently reviewing the suggested bags for the ballot bins and supplies. The vender is working with us to develop the bags.

### STUDENT WORKERS

Mr Duffy has reached out to the Personnel Department to find a way that students under the age of 18 could work the polls without obtaining Student Working Papers. NJ Title 19 allows this but the Warren County Administration has not.

### **SVRS**

Mr Duffy informed the Commissioners that there is a new vender for the new SVRS. It is KnowInk which is out of St. Louis MO.

Mr. Brown made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Boddy seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken with the motion passing unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 4:15 PM.
