#### REPORTS AND COMMENTS

County Counsel Joe Bell said he had a few litigation updates for discussion in Executive Session.

County Engineer Bill Gleba reported that he had a draft, working copy of an alternative analysis for Spring Valley Road in Hardwick Township. Once finalized, Mr. Gleba said he would approach the NJ DEP to request a pre-application meeting. "We're probably going to have to modify the roadway elevation," he said, noting that the drainage system alterative appeared to be a very expensive endeavor.

County Planner Dave Dech had no report.

County Public Works Director Emily Hammer reported on progress regarding the vehicle fleet electrification initiative she was pursuing with Mr. Kern. While at the October NJAC Conference, Ms. Hammer said she began comparing other counties' best practices with respect to vehicles available through state contract cooperative purchasing, as well as planning effective routes and charging station locations, and which departments would be a good place to start.

She talked a bit about financing possibilities – for chargers, electric vehicles, large fleet funding through emissions reductions - with all programs being administered through the NJ DEP. There were various funding deadlines; some firm and some on a rolling basis, with a hard deadline for electric vehicles coming up in March of 2022. In addition to NJAC, Ms. Hammer was looking into the National Association of Counties to discover how funding would filter down from the federal infrastructure legislation. She was set to attend a follow-up meeting with the DEP the following week. Budgeting for the initiative would commence in 2022.

Mr. Sarnoski inquired about the status of Courtroom #1 renovations. Ms. Hammer said it was going well and on schedule, with the board's annual reorganization meeting set to take place there on New Year's Day. "We will be up and running in time as planned," she said.

County CFO Kim Francisco had no report.

County Administrator Alex Lazorisak had only the vacancy report for the board's review.

#### **COMMISSIONER COMMENTS**

Ms. Ciesla apologized for missing the last meeting, saying she had been away and it was good to be back. She planned to present a proclamation to the Health & Wellness Field Day Committee at the board's next regular meeting, and the group was planning its next event to be held indoors over the winter.

Regarding federal funding to improve broadband, Ms. Ciesla said she spoke to several people at the League of Municipalities conference, and thought we should be working together regionally, including across the Delaware River.

Mr. Sarnoski had no report, but wished all a Happy Thanksgiving.

Mr. Kern announced his intention to have a resolution on the next meeting's agenda to create an environmental advisory committee. "The goal of this will be to assist the Warren County Board of Commissioners and to serve the general public in order to protect and restore Warren County's natural resources, and to increase awareness ensuring that both residents and visitors alike can enjoy a healthy environment and improved quality of life," he said, adding that the group would work

with different boards and agencies, local environmental commissions, colleges, universities, community groups and private sector businesses.

In closing, Mr. Kern said he hoped everyone would have a happy, healthy and safe Thanksgiving.

There were no closing public comments, nor questions from the press.
