Morris Canal Greenway Improvements

When constructed in the 1830's, the Morris Canal extended approximately 102 miles from Philipsburg on the Delaware River to Jersey City on the Hudson River. The Morris Canal Greenway Study developed guidelines to convert the former canal route to an active recreational facility for walking and bicycling. Warren County has received a Federal Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant to improve over 4 miles of the Greenway spanning portions of Greenwich, Franklin, Mansfield, Independence, and Hackettstown.

The proposed project will include installation of a new crushed gravel path, grading improvements to improve accessibility, driveway and sidewalk improvements at the Jim & Mary Lee Canal Museum, and replacement of an existing wooden pedestrian bridge.

This virtual meeting is being held to present an overview of the project, as well as invite participants to submit questions/comments to the project team. Following the meeting, the presentation will be available through the Warren County website until April 20, 2022 with the opportunity to provide feedback.
