RESOLUTION REGULATING COMMERCIAL FILMING IN AND AROUND THE COUNTY OF WARREN

- **WHEREAS**, the County of Warren has been cited in various magazines and media outlets as one of the best places to live in the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the County of Warren offers ample parks, beautiful tree lined streets, historic homes, and a bustling County for its residents and visitors to enjoy; and
- **WHEREAS**, due to these benefits, many members in the TV and movie industry enjoy filming in the County of Warren; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the residents' best interest to enact appropriate legislation to allow for filming to occur within the County while preserving the quality of life and ensuring the safety of the residents and those involved; and
- WHEREAS, this Resolution will regulate the issuance of permits for commercial and educational filming within the County of Warren; and
- WHEREAS, this Resolution will enable fire, police, and other County departments and/or agencies to support various members in the media industry; and
- WHEREAS, this Resolution will allow the governing body to enact legislation to protect its residents from any additional exposure; and
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren, State of New Jersey as follows:
- Section 1. Definitions.

As used in this Resolution, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

<u>FILMING</u> - The taking of still or motion pictures, either on film, videotape, digital or similar recording medium, for commercial or educational purposes intended for viewing on video receivers, television, in theaters, the Internet or for institutional use.

<u>DISPLAY</u> - To promote, issue, sell, transmit, distribute, exhibit or advertise.

<u>PUBLIC LANDS</u> - Any and every public street, highway, sidewalk, square, public right of way, public park or playground, public building and property or other public place within the County which is within the jurisdiction and control of the County of Warren.

<u>FILM CREW MEMBERS</u> - Directors, producers, actors, set members, camera crew members, security, contractors, interns, and agents.

Section 2. Permits.

- a. No person shall film or permit filming within the County of Warren without first obtaining a permit therefore, which permit shall set forth the location of such filming, time and the date or dates when the filming shall take place. A permit application shall be filed at least thirty (30) days prior to the first date that filming is to take place.
- b. Permits shall be obtained in the Office of the County Administrator during normal business hours and applications for such permits shall be in a form approved by the County Administrator.
- c. If a permit is issued and, due to inclement weather or other good cause beyond the applicant's control, filming does not in fact take place on the dates specified, the County Administrator may, at the request of the applicant, issue a new permit for filming on other dates subject to full compliance with all other provisions of this Resolution. No additional fee shall be required for said permit.
- d. The permit is not transferable.

Section 3. Rules and Regulations.

- a. No permit shall be issued for filming upon public lands within the County of Warren unless the applicant for such permit:
 - i. Provides proof of insurance coverage for bodily injury for any one person in the amount of \$1,000,000.00, any aggregate occurrence in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 and a \$5,000,000 umbrella. The County of Warren shall be named as an additional insured on the policy and a Certificate of Insurance shall be delivered to the County at the time that the application is filed.
 - ii. Agrees in writing to indemnify and save harmless the County of Warren from any and all liability or damages resulting from the use of such public lands.
 - iii. Provides proof of service of written notification of proposed dates and locations to be used for production activities to any and all property owners who will be directly affected by the filming and site location(s).
- b. The holder of a permit shall take all reasonable steps to minimize interference with the free passage of pedestrians and traffic over public lands and shall comply with lawful directives issued by the New Jersey State Police and/or local jurisdictional authority with respect thereto. When, in the judgment of the Chief of Police or other Executive Law Enforcement Officer, or their designee, the presence of additional security in the form of police, fire or code enforcement personnel are required in connection with the filming, the applicant shall reimburse the County for the cost of such personnel.
- c. The holder of a permit shall conduct filming in such a manner as to minimize the inconvenience or discomfort to adjoining property owners attributable to such filming and shall, to the extent practicable, abate noise and park vehicles associated with such filming off the public streets.

- d. The holder of a permit shall take all reasonable steps to minimize the creation and spread of debris and rubbish during filming and shall be responsible for removing all equipment, debris and other rubbish from the filming location upon the completion of filming.
- e. The County Administrator may refuse to issue a permit whenever they determine, on the basis of objective facts and after a review of the application and a report thereon by the State Police, local authority, and/or other County agencies, that filming at the location and/or time set forth in the application would violate any law or Resolution or would unreasonably interfere with the use and enjoyment of adjoining properties, unreasonably impede the free flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic or otherwise endanger the public's health, safety or welfare.
- f. In addition to any other fees or costs associated with this Resolution, the applicant shall reimburse the County for any lost revenue or repairs to public property.

Section 4. Fees

The schedule of fees for the issuance of permits authorized by this chapter are as follows:

- a. Application fee \$500.00
- b. Filming fee \$500 per day
- c. Expedited processing fee (applies to any application filed less than 30 days prior to production or requires processing in 14 days or less) \$1,000 application fee, plus \$1,000/day filming fee
- d. Application amendment fee (applies to each amendment to an approved application) \$250.00

Section 5. Exemptions

- a. The provisions of this Resolution shall not apply to the filming of news stories within the County of Warren.
- b. Filming performed by one individual using a hand-held camera without assistance from others shall be exempt from this Resolution.
- c. Fees may be waived for students enrolled in a bona fide educational institution upon receipt by the County Administrator of written certification from a teacher or administrator of that institution stating that the filming is for educational purposes only and not intended for commercial use.

RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL TO PURCHASE A .918 ACRE PROPERTY KNOWN AS BLOCK 14, LOT 11.01 IN FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the permanent preservation of lands devoted to open space is in the public interest and benefits the citizens of Warren County and that the purchase of open space to accomplish the preservation of said land is a worthwhile and prudent expenditure of public funds; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Open Space, Farmland, and Historic Trust Fund makes monies available for the purchase of open space in order to permanently preserve said properties; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Board of Recreation Commissioners recommends that the Trust Fund be used to acquire a .918 acre property known as Block 14, Lot 11.01 in Franklin Township; and

WHEREAS, two professional independent market appraisal reports were prepared on the adjacent Block 15, Lots 1 and 4 parcels for Farmland Preservation which are owned by the same landowner as Block 14, Lot 11.01; and

WHEREAS, the adjacent Block 15, Lots 1 and 4 have been approved for farmland preservation by the Warren County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the landowner has agreed to accept the amount of \$15,150.00 per acre for the Open Space parcel, Block 14, Lot 11.01, Franklin Township for the fee simple purchase dedicated to the purchase intended for advancement of the Morris Canal Trail; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board hereby excludes the public in order to discuss such matters. The general nature of the subjects to be discussed are as follows:

- (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.
- (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.
- (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds:

Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.

- (6) Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of possible violations of the law.
- (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or many become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.
- (8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance or promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.
- (9) Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty: Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bearing responsibility.
