Employees who marry or become related by marriage may continue in their employment if the marriage does not result in the creation of a prohibited relationship. Where the marriage results in the creation of a prohibited relationship, the Employer will explore potential accommodations including the reassignment of one or both employees to available positions for which the employees are qualified.

For purposes of this policy, immediate relative includes spouse or significant other, child, stepchild, parent, stepparent, sibling, grandparents, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, grandchildren, or any person with whom the employee has an intimate or dating relationship.

Applicability:

This policy applies to all Warren County Correctional Officers hired, promoted, transferred, or assigned on or after the date of adoption and to all prohibited relationships created on or after the date of adoption.
