**WHEREAS**, these motor vehicles are used to transport property that has or displays a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 or more pounds; and

WHEREAS, it has become a common occurrence for these motor vehicles to: collide with low vertical clearances, use weight restricted roadways and roadways that are not designed and constructed for these type of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, these occurrences cause damage to the infrastructure of our roadways, require first responder assistance due to accidents, create unusual traffic situations and delays and puts Warren County residents in danger; and

WHEREAS, S-2643 and A-975 would help to decrease these issues by requiring commercial motor vehicles to be equipped with a global positioning system navigation program that provides information about upcoming highway infrastructure with low vertical clearance, weight restrictions, and dynamic route directions that account for commercial motor vehicle restrictions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren does hereby support S-2643, a bill introduced to the New Jersey State Senate on May 16, 2022 by Senator Steven V. Oroho of District 24 and co-sponsored by Douglas J.
