REPORTS AND COMMENTS

County Counsel Joe Bell had nothing to report this evening.

County Engineer Bill Gleba provided an update of County Route #659, Spring Valley Road, Hardwick Township, the geotechnical drawing will be released. There will be a road closure for two days, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Detour is in place, buses will be able to get through in the morning and afternoon.

Mr. Sarnoski asked about the scheduling of the Route #659 construction project. Mr. Gleba is awaiting a reply from New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection regarding the restrictions, hoping to have more information next month.

County Planner Dave Dech provided an update on the Capital Improvement Plan that had been reported at last meeting. Mr. Dech has submitted comments regarding the following projects:

- County Route #519/Route 57 Intersection project no response has been received to date.
- I-80 Rock wall project and I-80 Retaining Wall Replacement project New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJ DOT) held a virtual local public officials meeting on Monday, May 22, 2023, Mr. Dech attended, Ms. Mezzanotte, as an official to Knowlton Township, and the Mayor of Knowlton Township along with other committee members. However, Hardwick Township was not invited. NJ DOT insisted that the retaining wall project is not a part of the rock wall project. Mr. Dech noted this in the comments submitted to NJ DOT, these projects need to be considered as one project, and you cannot do one project without doing the other, this is a segmentation of the project along with violation of federal

policy.

Mr. Dech also brought to the Board's attention, NJ DOT is not looking to fix the S turns on I-80, and this project will not be looked at for at least ten years. This runs contrary to the resolutions passed by Hardwick Township, Knowlton Township and Warren County. Mr. Dech recommends an additional resolution be passed to re-enforce this issue. Discussion took place at this time regarding preparing an additional resolution verses sending a letter addressed to Congressman Kean. The Board requested a draft resolution for proposing at the next meeting.

County Public Works Director Emily Hammer had nothing to report this evening.

County CFO Kim Francisco had nothing to report this evening.

County Administrator Alex Lazorisak had only the latest personnel vacancy report, which contains backfilling of positions in Buildings and Grounds, Library and Road Department.

Ms. Ciesla gave a brief update of the Mental Health and Wellness day. This event was very successful, this is a way for us to share the resources that are available throughout the county. She thanked everyone for doing a great job as well as thanked all that came out to the event.

In regards to Broadband and Cellular update, Ms. Ciesla has been working with Ms. Hammer and Mr. Lazorisak regarding the public safety communications and collection of data. This information has woken up our providers to do more and do better for our county.

Ms. Ciesla took a moment to acknowledge the passing of Harry Brown. Mr. Brown served as an Election Board Member, federal employee and also with the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission. Please keep the family in your prayers.

CLOSING PUBLIC COMMENTS

Tara Mezzanotte, Knowlton Township official and I-80 DWG Coalition came before Board to give an update regarding the meeting with NJ DOT regarding I-80 projects. Ms. Mezzanotte has been appointed to the Knowlton Township Land Use. She had met with Congressman Kean, received contact information for Council on Environmental Quality and United States DOT. Ms. Mezzanotte brought to the Board's attention, with the fact Warren County has been denied or ignored, if the

county was a cooperating agency the county could appeal and request a new lead agency to oversee the project. Federal Highway would need to consider the request.

Ms. Mezzanotte pointed out item of discussion in the meeting with NJ DOT, the project will be two lanes of traffic flowing at all times, despite the closeness of the repairs to the retaining wall being done. NJ DOT did not included Pennsylvania officials until Knowlton Township brought this to the attention of Pennsylvania.

The NJ DOT admitted that the retaining wall was not inspected until June 2022. Last year when it was claimed that they needed to replace the wall in April of 2022, this was done without inspections. In response to the correspondence sent by County Counsel asking if the roadway was safe, correspondence was received from NJ DOT the highway is safe, without inspections, once inspected immediate action was taken.

Ms. Mezzanotte stated, she reminds everyone when she talks regarding the I-80 projects, we support emergency repairs, and completely support reasonable rock fall mitigation, however do not support separation of the projects into two separate projects.

Liza Thomas, Liberty Township discussed the proposed legislation S-3907, Anti-book banning. Ms. Thomas is asking for the books to be moved to a more secure location along with check out of the books under parental approval.




