## RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ESTABLISHING A WEIGHT LIMIT OF 13 TONS FOR THROUGH TRAFFIC ON COUNTY ROUTE 517, COUNTY ROUTE 519 AND COUNTY ROUTE 521 IN WARREN COUNTY

- **WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Warren County have continually been concerned with large commercial motor vehicle (CMV) traffic and its impact on our county roads; and
- **WHEREAS**, Warren County has received significant public feedback and comments regarding large truck traffic on our county roadways; and
- **WHEREAS**, the increase in large scale warehousing development projects in both NJ and PA will significantly increase CMV traffic on our county roads: and
- WHEREAS, numerous fatal accidents involving trucks have occurred and any increases in truck traffic or the facilitation of these trucks would only increase the risks of vehicular incidents; and
- WHEREAS, The Warren County Board of County Commissioners unanimously passed Resolution 74-23 requesting changes to N.J.A.C. 16:32 to remove certain county roads unsuitable for travel by double-trailer truck combinations and 102-inch wide standard trucks from the Warren County Network System; and
- WHEREAS, there are numerous suitable alternative routes available for large truck traffic to pass through Warren County, such as the National Network Routes and State Highway system routes; and
- **WHEREAS**, on May 22, 2023 the Warren County Planning Board adopted the Warren County Transportation Maser Plan Amendment 2023, directing all commercial truck traffic to the properly designated State and Federal Highway Road System and
- WHEREAS, this decision was made after considering traffic volume, accident records, impact on schools and recreational areas, and the historic and environmental impacts; and
- **WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Transportation, NJDOT, retains jurisdiction to establish weight restrictions on all roadways for CMVs; and
- **WHEREAS** a letter and study dated May 2020 were prepared by and for Hope Township were submitted to the NJDOT in support of a 13-ton gross vehicle weight restriction citing pedestrian safety and preservation of historic buildings as the primary purpose of the CMV; and
- WHEREAS, our county roads should not be used as a means for large commercial motor vehicle traffic to pass through Warren County, and to only allow CMVs over 13-ton gross vehicle weight ratings (GVWR) if they are engaged in transportation for local deliveries or local businesses in Warren County; and
  - WHEREAS, these restrictions cannot go into effect without the NJDOT's approval:

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of County Commissioners, that the following roads have either been reviewed by the NJDOT or are in the process of review, and the restriction for vehicles having a registered gross vehicle weight rating of thirteen (13) tons and more from using the following roads as a means to travel through Warren County if they are not engaged in transportation for local deliveries or local businesses can go into effect immediately:

- 1. County Route 519 from the Northern County Boundary with Sussex County at mile marker 56.80 south to mile marker 50.15 at Route 80 in Hope Township
- 2. County Route 521 from mile marker 0.00 at the intersection with County Route 519 in Hope Township North to mile marker 6.05 at the intersection of Route 94 in Blairstown Township;
- 3. County Route 519 from mile marker 50.15 in Hope Township south to mile marker at Route 46 in White Township
- 4. County Route 519 from mile marker 42.05 at Route 46 south to mile marker 29.95 in Lopatcong Township at Route 57

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** the designated alternate for through traffic of CMV weight restricted trucks, that traffic that is not engaged in transportation for local deliveries or local businesses, be the National Network Routes and State Highway system routes; and

WHEREAS, Greenwich Street/Market Street (County Route 620), Water Street (County Route 620) and Water Street Spur (County Route 620) are County Roads under the jurisdiction of the County of Warren and subject to regulations established by the Warren County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, trucks are currently subject to an eight (8) ton weight restriction on Greenwich Street/Market Street (County Route 620), Water Street (County Route 620) and Water Street Spur (County Route 620), except for the pickup and delivery of materials on such streets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Belvidere has requested that the County of Warren adopt a Resolution consenting to Ordinance No. 2023x11; and

WHEREAS, municipalities are expressly authorized by statute to establish ordinances establishing weight-based restrictions designating streets and roads upon which buses and trucks may be required not to exceed specially fixed limits; and

WHEREAS, the County has received numerous requests on behalf of municipalities and law enforcement agencies throughout Warren County for greater authority to establish and enforce motor vehicle regulations on County Roads within their respective municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the importance of providing police and law enforcement with the means and tools necessary to effectively protect the safety of local roadways and of the motoring public of Warren County; and

**WHEREAS**, the County believes it is in the public interest to provide municipalities with additional means to be able to better and more effectively and comprehensively enforce traffic regulations on County Roads and throughout its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the County finds that the establishment and enforcement of the said traffic regulation by the municipality will improve the overall safety of the roadway and will otherwise protect the safety and wellbeing of residents, visitors and members of the motoring public; and

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are hereby adopted and incorporated herein as if repeated in full.

Trucks over eight (8) ton gross vehicle weight rating are hereby excluded from the following roads and streets, except for the pickup and delivery of material on such streets:

Greenwich Street/Market Street (County Route 620), between Town of Belvidere and Township of White municipal boundary and Water Street

Water Street (County Route 620), between Market Street and Town of Belvidere and Township of White municipal boundary

Water Street Spur (County Route 620) between Market Street and Railroad Trestle

3. Upon final adoption and approval of this consenting Resolution by the County, the Town of Belvidere shall be responsible for, and shall take all necessary actions to effectuate and enforce the regulations established under the Ordinance authorized hereunder, including the installation and placement of the appropriate signs and traffic control devices within the areas and locations and the conformance of the same with the provisions of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and Title 39 of the Revised Statutes Annotated of New Jersey. The municipality shall thereafter be responsible for maintenance, replacement and conformance of such signs and traffic control devices, except that the municipality shall be required to notify and obtain the

approval of the County Engineer as to the placement and location of any such signs and traffic control devices prior to installation.

- 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon final adoption, publication of the requisite public notice by the County and/or municipality, as applicable, and erection and placement of all signs, traffic control devices and traffic control signals in the locations where the regulation is effective as required by law.

#### RESOLUTION

On motion by , seconded by , the following resolution was unanimously adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren at a meeting held on December 13, 2023.

#### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE WARREN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROVIDING FOR A MEETING NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW JERSEY OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12

**WHEREAS**, the Warren County Board of County Commissioners is subject to certain requirements of the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A.* 10:4-6, et seq., and

**WHEREAS**, the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A.* 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that this Board hereby excludes the public in order to discuss such matters. The general nature of the subjects to be discussed are as follows:

- (1) *Matters Required by Law to be Confidential:* Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
- (2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.
- (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.
- (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.

- (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.
- (6) Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of possible violations of the law.
- (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or many become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.
- (8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance or promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.
- (9) Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty: Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bearing responsibility.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board shall disclose to the public, as soon as practicable, the contents of the discussions after the final disposition of the matters discussed.
