### PUBLIC COMMENTS (AGENDA ITEMS ONLY)

Courtney Murphy, CWA TASS 1032 – Spoke about agenda item E1. She referred to the people in the audience wearing the red t-shirts and said these women represent the dedication, hard work, loyalty, empathy and more. They provide Warren County residents with access to food, housing, health insurance, and cash assistance. They connect residents to employment and mental health services, child support, childcare, social security, legal services and more. They serve Warren County's most vulnerable population. She said she is sure the Board is aware their department is understaffed as well as underpaid. Currently there are 16 vacancies. They have employees making less than the 2024 state minimum wage, adding some employees work second jobs just to survive. They have employees who apply for the same income-based assistance they administer daily to our residents. Due to the extremely low salaries, they have minimal to no applicants for jobs posted throughout the county. They have high producing, well qualified employees looking for other employment or leaving the agency monthly due to low pay and high stress environment. She asked,

"What incentives can they give these employees to stay here? What is the outcome if their staff level becomes less and less?" Warren County residents ultimately suffer. Cases cannot be processed, timely benefits are left unmet and residents are left with insufficient funds for their daily needs. Their ultimate goal is to retain highly qualified employees, to best serve our most vulnerable population and to approve our residents' quality of life by adequately providing these services to them. As they negotiate their 2024-2026 union contract, they stand here tonight, united and strong, to ask for the Board's support. Support to provide livable wages to employees, support to help fully staff their agencies to be able to better serve residents in Warren County. They look forward to building more working relationship with the Board. She thanked the Board for their time.

County Counsel Joseph Bell IV, had nothing to report this evening.

County Engineer William Gleba provided an update on the Harmony Brass Castle Road Bridge #22040, Washington Township. Pavement is in now and, with weather permitting, will get the striping down, and the guiderails done. He's hoping by the end of next week to have the road opened back up.

County Planner Dave Dech had no report this evening.

County Public Works Director Emily Hammer gave a brief update on the FEMA recovery process. They are moving into design for mitigation, which are those projects that are going to create resiliency along county roads. Tonight the Board approved design services for one spot along Brass Castle Road. They will build more strength, a wall structure and addressing the path of the stream so they can protect what's happened downstream. The Board is also approving engineering services for County Road #635, Snyders Road, Pohatcong Township.

County CFO Kim Francisco had no report this evening.

County Administrator Alex Lazorisak had a couple of items for this evening.

- 1. February 14, 2024 Board of School Estimate Meeting with the Warren County Community College is set to begin at 5:00 p.m. Mr. Lazorisak asked the Board would they want to move back the Regular Commissioner meeting time to 7:00 p.m.? On motion by Mr. Sarnoski, seconded by Mr. Kern to change the Commissioners Regular Session meeting to 7:00 p.m., Recorded vote: Ms. Ciesla absent, Mr. Sarnoski yes, Mr. Kern yes.
- 2. Latest vacancy report, nothing out of the ordinary. As reported last month, we are seeing a slow influx of new hires coming in. With the economy and demographics and everything that's happening out there on a federal level, we're starting to see people come back to work.

### **COMMISSIONER COMMENTS**

Mr. Sarnoski will be participating in a meeting tomorrow afternoon regarding Catswamp Road with Allamuchy Township to discuss the roadwork in Allamuchy.

Mr. Kern reported on discussions that took place last year regarding bringing in an independent auditor to look at the Board's response to the storms last summer. The kickoff meeting was held this past week and he thinks it's a good start. He expressed his appreciation for the county departments who participated. It was a good start of the conversation about what we can learn and what we can improve. Some department heads have already made some changes which he thinks have been successful. The storm was not only a significant financial cost, but also an increase in the workloads of employees. They are hoping to meet again in February.

County Administrator Lazorisak added Mr. Bird from Preparedness 360 Solutions, LLC will tally all the information. He did meet with all the department heads after the main meeting. He visited the OEM building and was very impressed with all that we have and with our abilities. He was also impressed with Dennis Riley and Michael Petruzzellis. Mr. Bird has a lot of knowledge and has worked on large disasters, like Hurricane Katrina. It's good to have a third party insight.

Mr. Kern also announced that Warren County is going to be starting the Commissioner Conservation Challenge. The goal is to make Warren County the first National Wildlife Federation Certified County in the state of New Jersey. Individual homeowners, renters or whomever can work to have their individual property certified for wildlife habitats. This means, a lot of times in our own backyards, sometimes we're planting things that aren't native species, such as different plants. It makes it hard for all types of plants and animals to survive. Just by designating a tiny spar in your backyard, you can help get this certification. We've hit that goal of the amount which we will put in our press release tonight. We'll be the first county in New Jersey to get that certification. Some of our neighboring counties are pretty close to us as far as getting that certification. It's something everyone can do and get involved within the community. Since 1973, the National Wildlife Federation has certified 250,000 sites. It could be a small thing like putting out water for hummingbirds or adding

different types of flowers for bees. You can do it as a property owner, whether owning or renting, do it at your church, do it at your business, or do it at your municipal building. Let's see if we can get that done. More information to follow. He thanked Clairanne Arcaro who's on the Allamuchy Green Team. I think between her and Hope, Warren County's already halfway there in getting this designation. He appreciates all the work they've already done. He mentioned a meeting that will be taking place on Monday, February 12<sup>th</sup>, in Washington Borough. Jen from Warren County Parks will be doing a presentation, Gardening for Wildlife, on how to get your property certified. It will be held at the Washington Public Library. More details can be found on the County's website.

#### **CLOSING PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Tara Mezzanotte, I80 DWG Coalition gave an update regarding I80. NJ DOT has finally scheduled our local officials briefing for both the rock fall mitigation and retaining wall projects. Knowlton and Hardwick Townships and Warren County are participating. Congressman Kean will have representation there. Assemblyman DiMaio himself will be there. She noted this is the first update to Hardwick and Knowlton Townships since 2020. She also reported she met with Assemblyman DiMaio, several weeks ago, for a few hours, to brief him on the projects. She wanted to mention this publicly so people realize that that kind of support is present. Assemblyman DiMaio is engaged, he is interested and information is going out to them. It was also noted the support that has been received from the County, particularly from the Board of County Commissioners, Dave Dech, Planning Director, and Ms. Mezzanotte herself for continuing the discussion with all the towns. All have continued to press the DOT for open communications.
