2024 APPLICATION TO THE MUNICIPAL AND CHARITABLE CONSERVANCY TRUST FUND COMMITTEE

DEADLINE: June 14, 2024

- Each application question must be addressed, even if not applicable.
- One (1) original application and fourteen (14) copies, including all required documents, must be submitted. Applications without the requisite number of copies will be rejected. *Double-sided printing is encouraged.
- All copies must be three-hole punched and collated. Attach each copy at the top with a binder clamp. Do not submit applications in binders.
- All applications must be typed. No handwritten applications will be accepted.
- Do not attach any materials that are <u>not</u> expressly requested in this application; any other materials will not be accepted. Additional materials concerning your application may be presented at Municipal and Charitable Conservancy Trust Fund Committee meetings; the Department of Land Preservation may contact you for additional information.
- A site visit of the project location will be scheduled by the Department of Land Preservation. A representative for the project must attend this visit. Municipal and Charitable Conservancy Trust Fund Committee members will also be present at the site visit.
- An eight (8) minute presentation to the Municipal and Charitable Conservancy Trust Fund Committee is required as part of this application process. The presentation will be scheduled by the Department of Land Preservation for a Municipal and Charitable Conservancy Trust Fund Committee meeting (a laptop and projector will be available at the meeting). Applicants may provide a DVD or PowerPoint presentation.
